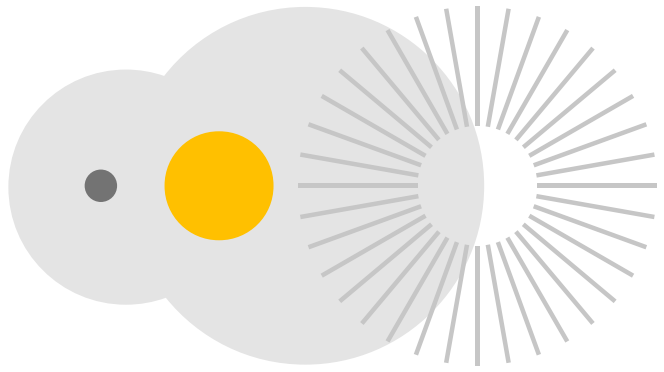

Fascinating Facts about the European Green Belt

- Length: 12,500 km
- 24 Countries
- 40 National parks
- 3272 Nature conservation areas
- Represents almost all ecoregions of Europe from arctic to the black see
- Open borders with great potential for cross border cooperation



What makes a workcamp an EGB workcamp?

- The 5 Pillars of an EGB Workcamp

- Location within the European Greenbelt
- Working task with context to the EGB (Nature, historical, cultural)
- Exchange with locals
- Strengthen intercultural cooperation between member countries
- Experience a nature conservation network/corridor



Ideas on how to share the spirit of the EGB

Visit or hike along nature conservation sites
(Visit of a bird ringing station)

Meet locals + guided tours from locals to nature, historical and cultural sites (ruins, burial mounds, wine cellars..)

Visit local restaurants together with locals
(Heurigen)

Workshops on the history of the region + European Green Belt + Biodiversity...

Working together with locals

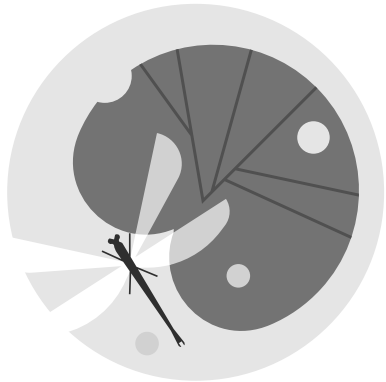


What do volunteers get from an EGB Workcamp?
